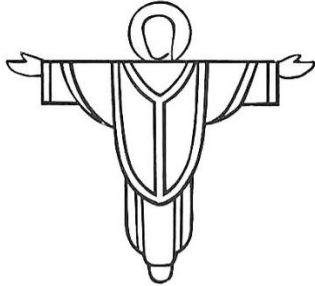


FIFTH ANNUAL BISHOP MICHAEL J. GALLAGHER SOCIETY AWARD DINNER

Sister Geraldine Kaczynski, FSSJ. Sr. Geraldine began her career teaching at St. Josephat Grade School in Milwaukee, Wi.(1968-1974). Sister Geraldine has served as a classroom teacher through 1976, and as Principal 1976 - Present - St. Sebastian, Dearborn Hts., Mi. She attended St. Valentine Grade School and Immaculata High School in New York. She did her Undergrad at D'Youville in Buffalo, N.Y. and Graduate work at Marygrove College in Detroit, Mi. Sister Geraldine continues to foster the spiritual development of St. Sebastian's faculty and students.

Ms. Gail D. Bilkie. Ms. Bilkie taught first grade at Shrine Catholic Grade School, Royal Oak, Mi. 1968-2011. She attended St Ambrose and St. Matthew Grade Schools, and both Dominican and St. Ambrose High Schools. MSU Undergrad, University of Detroit, Wayne State, San Jose State (Ca.) Graduate work. She continues to teach and mentor through her current volunteer efforts.

Lou Miramonti. Mr. Miramonti has served for over four decades as a teacher, coach, and athletic director mostly at Royal Oak Shrine High School where the football field bears his name. Lou is an accomplished and much loved cross country and track coach. He is then only person to be named the Catholic League's Athletic Director of the year three times in his career and was recognized with its highest honor, the Ed Lauer Person of the Year in 1988. Lou retired from active service as Shrine High School's Athletic Director in 2002 and continues as one of the states finest track and cross country starts and meet referees.
